As soon as you step on the soil of Flying Eagle Ranch you know that you have found something rare. It is a great place for anyone to come and enjoy the country lifestyle in a clean atmosphere. Depending upon the character of ones visit, these different activities may be enjoyed: trail rides, riding lessons, hayrides, cookouts and bonfires, birthday parties, and summer camp programs. There are also tons of little things at the ranch that make the visit even more pleasurable: ball field, volleyball court, miniature golf, game room, swimming pool, recreation center, pond with dock and paddle boats, and restroom facilities. The Flying Eagle Ranch can also accommodate large group events such as church outings or festivals, family reunions, and school field

trips. The ranch also provides horse-drawn carriage services for weddings and special occasions.

The riding lessons that are offered are given by competent and able instructors. These lessons lead to a heightened awareness and will increase your confidence and enjoyment of riding. We especially like to welcome less experienced and uncertain riders who want to learn and gain confidence. The trail riding experience is also a great time for individuals and family to spend time relaxing and enjoying nature.

The summer camp programs are full of wonderful activities. The Flying Eagle Ranch counselors are a fun bunch who does more than supervise the children; they are active participants in all the activities as well. Now that's energy! When kids are exhausted from riding horses and participating in their camps workshops there are many other options available including field games, volleyball, kickball, miniature golf, swimming, and much, much more. The recreation room is well stocked with foosball, ping pong,



and games for indoor entertainment. The campers stay in air conditioned cabins. All Camp sessions at the ranch begin and end each day with personal devotions, prayer time, and good Bible preaching.

The horse camps offer terrific riding opportunities for the child that has riding knowledge that they wish to expand, as well as the child that just wants to begin their adventure with horses. Not only will they have a personal horse for the week but riding with the counselors and other children is a great way to develop friendships. Your child will spend hours in the saddle in addition to classroom sessions on: anatomy, grooming, nutrition/health, tack, and western horsemanship. Riding instruction will be given by competent, professional instructors.

The Bible camp week will be packed full with exciting field games, team building sports, horseback riding, swimming, paddle-boating, and singing by the camp fire. Don't forget the funny skits and great food! Each day will begin and end with Bible preaching and Christ-honoring music.

The music camp week is offered because Levi Rose and his family believe that music is one of God's greatest gifts to man. They wish to help equip young people with the ability they need to honor and glorify God with their music. Each camper will have two private piano lessons along with hours of classroom instruction in the areas of: Music Theory, Music Technique, Music Philosophy, and Music Performance. All campers will have an opportunity to play in the daily services, and to perform in the concert at the close of the week.
